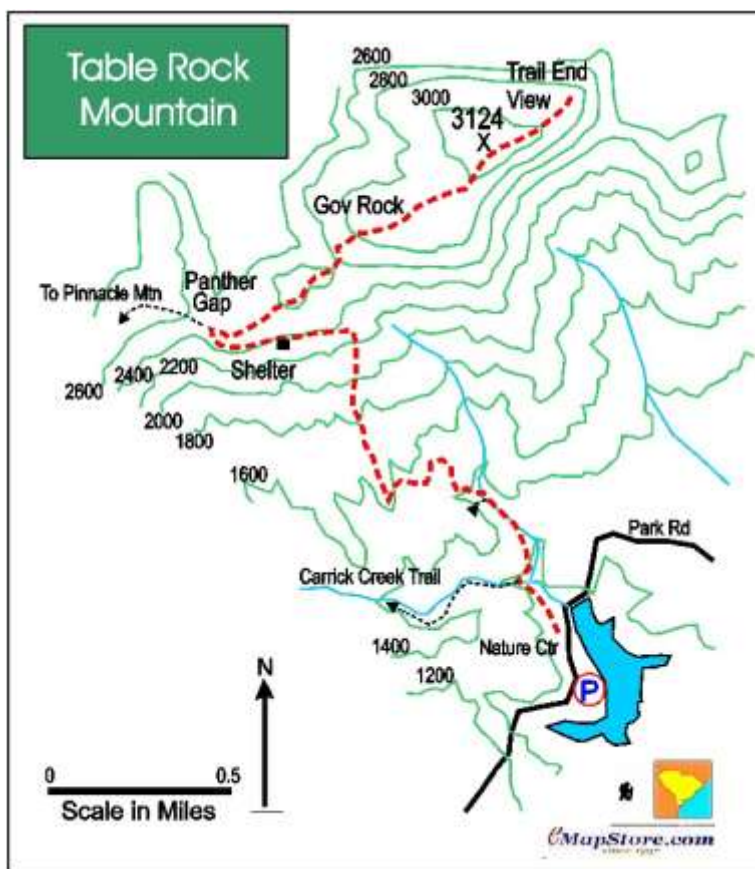


Table Rock Mountain SC Hike

Table Rock Mtn (3,124 ft) SC Vistas Views Granite - What a Great Hike!

Directions to Trail-Head: Table Rock Mountain is located in Table Rock State Park, along SC 11 in Northern Pickens County, SC. The trail head in the park is at the Carrick Creek Interpretive Center with parking across the road (Approximate GPS Coordinates 35°01'54.75"N 82°41'58.32"W).

Trail Summary: Begin on paved nature trail at the interpretive center. The trail changes to a dirt surface within 0.2 miles. Within the first mile the trail climbs moderately through the Green Creek Valley. While still in the valley, a side trail bears left. Stay right on the main trail. The hike becomes strenuous as the trail steepens, climbing rock stairs and passing through a boulder field. At 1.6 miles the trail passes a small open sided shelter. The trail continues to climb and at 2 miles reaches the summit ridgeline at Panther Gap. Bear right toward Table Rock Mountain. The trail rises and falls moderately along the ridge arriving at Governor's Rock at 2.6 miles with excellent views toward the west. Enter the woods and climb moderately to the wooded summit at 3.2 miles. For an excellent view toward the northeast continue along the trail, descending another 0.3 miles to the top of a rock face. Return along same route. Make sure to bear left at Panther Gap toward the trail head.



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
